The Dearbhfine of Clan MacCarthy Reagh; To All To Whom These Presents Shall Come, Greetings:

Whereas the Clan of MacCarthy Reagh of Carbery, as a Royal and Princely House descended
from the Kings of Desmond and Munster, has been without a recognized Chief for these last two -
hundred and seventy-one years, and yet never lawfully divested of its inherent sovereign dignity nor of its juridical
capacity to appoint the same; And Whereas the hereditary Brehon of the MacCarthy Clan has affirmed the juridical
foundations by which the Chiefship of the Clan MacCarthy Reagh is today succeeded; And Whereas under Gaelic
jurisprudence the Dearbhfine of a deceased Chief endures until such time as the Dearbhfine shall acclaim his Tanist,
or otherwise elect a new Chief; And Whereas the Chiefship of the Name is a hereditary office vested in the Clan
Dearbhfine; And Whereas the Dearbhfine of the last Chief of the Name MacCarthy Reagh, never having been
lawfully dissolved, superseded, disbanded, or succeeded, does therefore subsist and is de jure and de facto the presently
constituted Clan Dearbhfine; And Whereas the legal capacity of the clan to determine its own Chief was never
statutorily extinguished, but was merely impeded by the civil proscription of Tanistry; And Whereas the Principality
of Carbery was surrendered in 1606 to hold from the English Crown by knight's service in capite whereby the
hereditary custom of Tanistry was forced into desuetude; And Whereas the English Tenures Abolition Act 1660,
together with the Irish Tenures Abolition Act 1662, the Statute Law Revision Act 1962, and the Land and
Conveyancing Law Reform Act 2009 and cognate measures, have abrogated and countermanded every residual
incident of that feudal tenure; And Whereas the 1608 adjudication in O'Neill v. O'Neill favouring succession by
primogeniture rather than by Tanistry appertained to corporeal estates in land, its decision in respect of Irish dignities
inasmuch as an Irish Chiefship is an incorporeal dignity neither appurtenant to, nor dependent upon, any territorial
estate, the said judgment is incapable of governing, constraining, or otherwise affecting the hereditary succession to a
Gaelic Chiefship; And Whereas neither the Constitution of the Irish Free State, the Bunreacht na hÉireann, nor the
Statute Law Revision Acts and cognate measures disclose any express or implied enactment which repeals, abrogates,
annuls, suppresses, or otherwise extinguishes the hereditary dignity of any Gaelic Chiefship or the customary right
of a clan Dearbhfine to choose, recognise, and proclaim its Chief, and with courtesy recognitions by the Chief Herald
of Ireland having lapsed for want of legislative basis, the authority and prerogative to identify, elect, and proclaim a
Chief remains wholly vested in the Clan Dearbhfine in foro domestico;

We Therefore are graciously pleased, accordingly within Our ancient authority as the Dearbhfine of the MacCarthy
Reagh Clan of Carbery, for Us, Our heirs, and successors do appoint and by these presents advance, create, and
recognize our beloved cousin

Euan Patrick McCarthy Reagh of Oak Bluffs

to the state, degree, style, dignity, title, and honour of

Chief of the Name MacCarthy Reagh and Prince of Carbery,
et cetera;

with all the honours, privileges, rights, and prerogatives appertaining thereto; and, as the O'Driscoll bestowed the
White Rod into his hand, that distinction is conferred upon him, he is invested with that honour, and he is elevated to
nobility to hold and maintain that status, rank, style, dignity, title, and honour, with remainder to his heirs according
to the Ancient Law of Tanistry. In Witness Whereof We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and
have hereunto caused the Great Seal of The MacCarthy Reagh to be affixed this fourteenth day of August, the Vigil
of the Assumption, in the year of Our Lord two thousand and twenty-five.
